Subject(s): AP Calculus AB

Grade Level: 11th and 12th

Homework

- Homework will be assigned nightly.
- Expect to spend an average of 1.5 hours per block devoted in completing homework.
- Little (if any) class time will be devoted to answering homework questions. For homework assistance, students should collaborate with each other or stay after school for help.
- Work must be shown to receive credit.
- Incomplete work will not be given credit until completed.
- Late work carries a penalty.
- Homework will count 10% of 9 weeks grade.

Late Work

- No late work is accepted for the unit after the unit test is given.
- Late graded assignment will carry a penalty of 10 points per day after the due date.
- Late homework is given half of the original credit.

Explanation of Zeroes

- A grade of **ZERO** will be given for any work not made up within the given time frame until such work is completed.

Reassessment

Students may have an option to retest unit assessments provided the following conditions are met:

- At least 80% of homework is completed for the unit.
- Test corrections must be completed with 90% accuracy or attend a mandatory help session.
- **Maximum recovery grade is 90%.**

Make-up Work

- Students are expected to make up any test or quiz within one week upon returning to class.
- Any class work or homework missed due to an absence must be completed by the following class meeting after the student returns to school.
- It is the student's responsibility to arrange for make-up work. **Check WEEBLY.**

- Class time will not be used to make up work missed. Work may be made up during lunch/study block, before or after school.

Extra Credit

Students may earn 5 points for attending after school and off campus study session. A maximum of 10 may be earned for each unit test.
