Who receives priority? Immigrants, refugees, and minorities which includes Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (POC). You must be **age 18** and older for the Moderna vaccine.

Do you need to be a US citizen to receive vaccine? You do **NOT** need to be a U.S. citizen to get the vaccine. ID and social security number is not required. Your information is kept confidential.

Other information about the vaccine event: The Moderna vaccine will be administered and requires two doses. Second doses will be provided at the same time and location on **Saturday, June 5th**. The vaccines are **FREE** for everyone.
