 - If soap and water are not readily available, **use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol.** Wear your mask over your nose and mouth.

- All males 18 years of age are required to register with Selective Service. It is a civic duty and legal obligation to register. By not registering, men risk their eligibility for future college loans and grants, job training, employments, and US citizenship for immigrants. Registration must be completed online within 30 days of your 18th birthday. To register go to <http://www.sss.gov>. You will need your social security number to complete the registration. The process will take approximately two minutes.
