To the Parents/Guardians of the Class of 2025:

Greetings from Central High School! I am sure it does not seem possible, but soon your child will complete middle school and begin high school. We are in the initial stages of pre-enrollment for next year, and in order to make this transition as smooth as possible, we would like to inform you of the **four-step** process to pre-enroll your student for high school.

First Step... Central High School counselors will virtually present to our two feeder middle schools. These dates are as follows:

February 16th: Bode (virtual presentation)

February 16th: Truman (virtual presentation)

During this time, CHS counselors will provide students with pre-enrollment information and a registration form for you to review. The registration form provides a list of classes that students can request to take freshmen year. Please read course descriptions and select course requests and alternates carefully since the requests will be used for students' official schedules. Course descriptions are available in the course catalog on the CHS Counseling website (central.sjsd.k12.mo.us/counseling_office). Students will need the registration form when completing the pre-enrollment process. Counselors will also talk with students about their Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP), high school credits, graduation requirements, athletic eligibility requirements and other ways to be successful in high school.

Second Step... Students at both Truman and Bode Middle School will complete their high school pre-enrollment by selecting class requests in PowerSchool at their middle school buildings. The courses selected during pre-enrollment are requests only, and official schedules will not be available until August. CHS counselors will be available to answer any questions about pre-enrollment. These dates are as follows:

February 18th: Truman Pre-Enrollment

February 18st: Bode Pre-Enrollment

Third Step... Future Indian Night will be offered virtually this year. More information will be available soon.

Fourth Step... In August, registration will take place for all students. At this time, students will be able to access their official schedules in PowerSchool. If first choices were not granted, then every effort will be made to give the student his/her alternate choice.
