REGISTRATION & DISMISSAL

- Register and pay quickly due to limited class space in some programs.
- **IMPORTANT** - Remember to update your child's information on FamilyID - grade/teacher/allergies/etc.
- **Teacher Notes:** Send a note to your child's McGovern/Burke-Memorial teacher on the first day of class stating that your child will be staying for an "After School Program" - include the class name and dates. Teacher notes are only required for classes that begin immediately after school.
- **McGovern & Burke-Memorial Dismissal:** Students will be dismissed outdoors in front of the main entrance doors. Program instructors will sign each student out. If a pick-up person changes, notify your child's school or Community Education.
- **Middle School Dismissal:** Students may be picked up by parents/guardians in front of the school. Late buses are not available this fall.
- The school nurse is not available during after school programs.
- A discount of 15% is offered to all active military family members.
- Scholarships, due to financial hardship, may be available by contacting Community Education at 508-533-3222 option 4.

ONLINE REGISTRATION & PAYMENT (preferred method)

1. Visit www.medwayschools.org. Select **Community Education** from the **Schools** menu. Select the link for **Online Registration: FamilyID** and log in or sign up.
2. Select your child's school - **School Programs Fall 2021** - then select program(s).
3. Complete **Registration Information** and update your child's grade and teacher; select the **Save and Continue** button.
4. Click the **Submit** button to pay electronically or by check. Once registration is processed, you will receive a confirmation email from *FamilyID*.
5. Payment is required to complete the registration.
 - **Credit Card/Debit Card/ACH** - Click the *UniPay Gold* link (<https://unipaygold.unibank.com>) in the email confirming registration. American Express, Discover and MasterCard credit (fee applied), MasterCard debit and ACH are accepted.
 - **Check** - Mail to Medway Community Education, 16 Cassidy Lane, Medway, MA 02053; reference course in memo section for accurate processing. Checks must be received within 5 days of registering.
6. A registration without payment does not hold a spot in a class or program.
