Strategy 1

- Expand family liaisons and differentiate assignments as needed to concentrate support for high needs schools
- Engage with a variety of community partners as we implement the two F.A.C.E. Community Centers

Strategy 2

- Explore transportation plans for MVHS and other sites to increase access for high needs student populations
- Explore purchase of electric buses
- Expand internet connectivity, similar to VHS project, at other school locations in the district

Strategy 3

- Explore additional support for Middle School counseling support for students
- Investigate student to counselor ratios in the county and state
- Expand social worker and counseling support for high needs student populations

Strategy 4

- Invest in the training of all staff regarding early interventions at K and 1st grade
- Investigate the ability to add the Hermanitas program to compliment the Encuentros program at the secondary level
- Expand distance learning options for the 21-22 school year
- Expanding course access for students at the high school level, including a 7th period
- Focus on programs for incoming students to bridge gaps in middle and high school
- Explore class size reduction for high needs student populations

Strategy 5

- Create a program to develop a talent pipeline from students to staff to recruit and train future teachers
- Develop recruitment strategies to diversify the administrative leadership

Next Steps:
