School Reopening Update

- Reconvene the Superintendent's Council for Innovative Learning, including sprint teams, to review the status of Vista Virtual and Classic and develop recommendations for adjustments to be presented during the December 15th School Board meeting.
- Provide surveys to parents and staff to gather feedback on the learning models.
- Investigate various types of tutoring programs to support students struggling with their grades.
- Ensure graduation checks for students in the Class of 2021.
- Continue to refine health and safety measures based on county feedback.
- Maintain the current school pivot thresholds for middle and high schools (two positive cases at one school or one positive case at three schools concurrently) until new criteria is approved by the school board.

Measure LL Facility Bond Mini-Workshop

- Move forward with the landscaping design proposal #2 for the redevelopment of the space once the portable classrooms are removed from the V-Wing at Vista High School.
- Shift the scope of work for the Lake and Madison project from the pedestrian pathway to student restrooms at Lake and shade structures at Madison.

General Fund Budget Workshop

- Look into an early tell or retirement incentive options.
- Look into strategies/marketing approaches to attract students who have left the district to charter schools.
