Program Highlights and Curriculum:

The Integrated Preschool Program is designed to meet the unique needs of all students. Our curriculum provides robust learning opportunities for students that follow the Massachusetts Guidelines for Preschool Learning Experiences.

We are committed to:

- Providing a language-based inclusive setting where children can learn, play, and grow while promoting each child's unique personality, learning style, and self-esteem;
- Fostering students' social and emotional skills throughout all preschool learning experiences;
- Collaborating as a team with school-based professionals to promote success for all learners;
- Providing a solid foundation of early learning skills to facilitate a smooth transition to Kindergarten; and
- Working together with families and providing ongoing communication as well as opportunities to take part in classroom activities.



Special Education Referral Process:

Students with an identified disability who are deemed eligible for an Individual Education Plan (IEP) are entitled to services. Team evaluations administered by school district personnel, in addition to outside agency evaluations, are considered to determine students' needs and eligibility. A limited number of community peers are also accepted into the program beginning at age 3 through a lottery process using a competitive, private tuition rate.

The Medway Integrated Preschool offers the following schedule options:

- Five-day morning session* from 8:50-11:10 am;
- Five-day afternoon session* from 12:10-2:30 pm
- Five full-day session* from 8:50-2:30 pm (limited availability)

*Starting in October 2018, the first Wednesday of each month there will be no morning preschool & the third Wednesday of each month there will be no afternoon preschool

No AM PreK: 10/3, 11/7, 12/5 1/2, 2/6, 3/6, 4/3, and 5/1

No PM PreK: 10/17, 11/21, 12/19, 1/16, 3/20, and 5/15
