

# LOCAL AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS GRAD'S MUST APPLY FOR IN ORDER To Be Considered

- **ALICE WILLMOTT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline: May 3)**
    - Must have attended Douglas Elementary School
    - Apply by letter with short history about yourself, your achievements, goals & community service.
  - **BACF YIP SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline: May 1)**
    - Must have participated in YIP program for a minimum 3 years
    - Accepted into a recognized post-secondary institution.
    - Proven academic capabilities with an average of 70% or higher in all subjects in the current school year.
      - A 75-100 word essay to be provided with the following information:
      - Demonstrating service to their community through volunteer activities
      - Any involvement in community/school clubs or groups
      - Leadership experience
      - Future goals
      - A letter from their YIP Teacher Advisor or Principal certifying the recipient's program involvement, character, and abilities.
  - **BRYCE WALDON MEMORIAL AWARD (Deadline May 3)**
    - Student must be in good academic standing & recognized as an individual of solid character.
    - Apply by letter with short autobiographical info, personal interests, goals & why you think you should receive this award.
- EDNA, RAY & MURRAY CHAPMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline May 3)**
- Student exhibits exemplary participation in community & school services.
  - Student plans to attend college, university or a Trades/Application program.

- Apply by letter describing your commitment to future goals & plans & should give evidence of current & past community and/or school service as well as copy of their university/college acceptance letter or your employer (if working in a Trade).

● **IRV POWERS BASEBALL SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline May 3)**

- Student must be accepted into a recognized CDN or US College/University.
- Provide a transcript, 80% or higher average in all grade 11 & 12 subjects
- 100-word essay with the following:
  - Demonstrating service to their community through volunteer activities
  - Involvement in community/school clubs or groups
  - Leadership experience
  - Future goals
  - Letter from their coach certifying their involvement in baseball/softball sportsmanship and leadership abilities.

● **R.M. of CORNWALLIS SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline May 3)**

- Student is a resident of Cornwallis Municipality (Bdn, Meadowbrook Village, Chater, Cottonwoods, Sprucewoods)
- Pursuing post-secondary education.
- Apply by letter with info about yourself & a copy of your Grade 12 Transcript.

● **SHILO & REGION SERVICE CLUB SCHOLARSHIP (Not Available for 2021)**

- Must be a resident of Shilo, Sprucewoods, Cottonwoods or Douglas area.
- Must be a dependent of a Shilo military member or DND civilian employee.
- Must be pursuing post-secondary education or training.
- Apply by completing application form provided by the Shilo & Region Service Club & mailing it to them.

● **2021 WESTMAN'S AWARD OF EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP (Deadline May 3)**

- Grade 12 graduating in 2021 in an area WCG service.
- Must be attending post-secondary school in MB & pursuing a career in technology.
- Proven academic excellence.
- History of volunteering and community service, and proven leadership skills.
