

CORPORATE LANDING MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Dress guidelines are designed to promote a standard of appearance that complements the learning environment. Students are expected to dress appropriately for the occasion. In addition to the VBCPS dress code, Corporate Landing Middle's dress code includes the following:

- Students must wear appropriate and safe footwear fastened at the ankle at all times (no flip-flops, slide sandals, etc.).
- Students must wear clothes as they were designed to be worn (e.g., buttoned, zipped up, tucked in, or belted). Pants should be pulled up and secured at the waist. Pajamas are not acceptable for school.
- Shorts/skirts may not expose the lower abdomen or buttocks. Shorts/skirts must be long enough to cover the mid-thigh.
- All tops must have sleeves. Students may not wear shirts with low cut necklines, spaghetti straps, tank tops, halter tops, backless blouses, or clothing constructed of see-through materials such as lace. Students may only wear leggings when worn with a shirt long enough to reach the mid-thigh.
- Skirts, shorts, and pants with rips and/or holes may not be worn if the holes are above the mid-thigh unless leggings or fabric is worn underneath the pants. Revealing clothing is prohibited.
- Head coverings unrelated to religious or medical purposes, such as hats and scarves are prohibited. If a hat is brought into the building, it must remain in the locker until the end of the school day. Bandanas are prohibited. Likewise, gloves may not be worn during the school day.
- Students may not wear lewd or suggestive clothing. Students may not wear apparel that advertises, glorifies, or symbolizes any illegal substances or is gang related.
- Students may not wear jewelry, clothing or have on their person items that might create a safety hazard. Chains may not be worn as adornment to clothes nor should any student carry a chain.
- Headphones and all parts of electronic devices must be out of sight upon entry into the school.

If there is doubt about a particular item of apparel, the student should contact a school administrator for a decision. If the item is deemed inappropriate, the student will be denied entrance to class and will report to ISS until the situation is corrected.

As a reminder, subsequent violations of the dress code will subject the student to disciplinary consequences.
