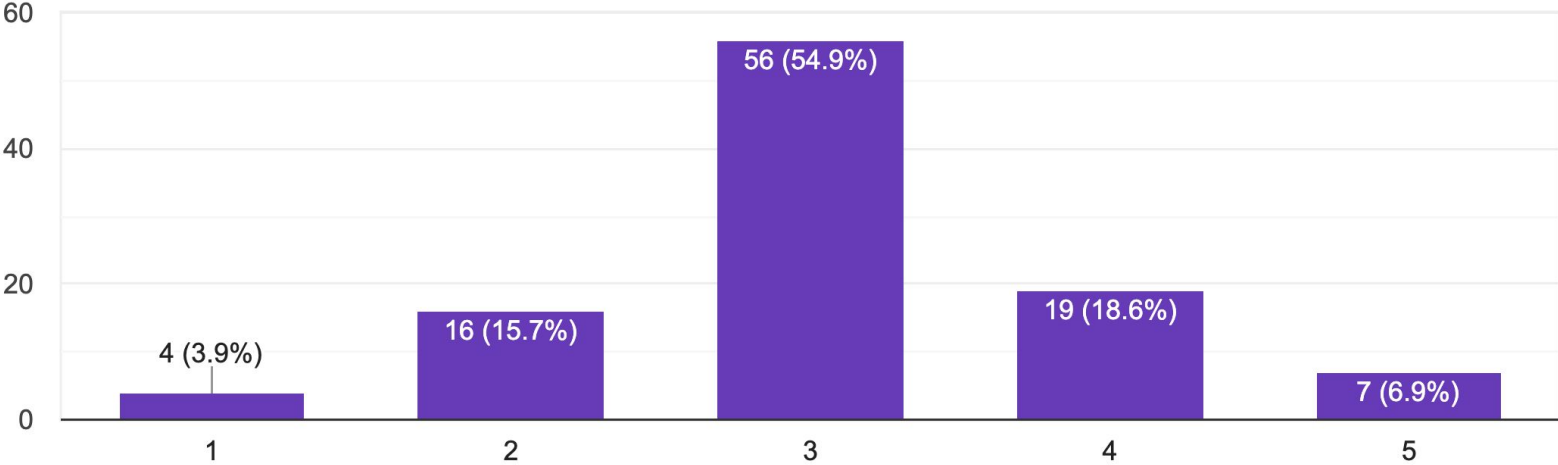

How are things going for you at L-S this year

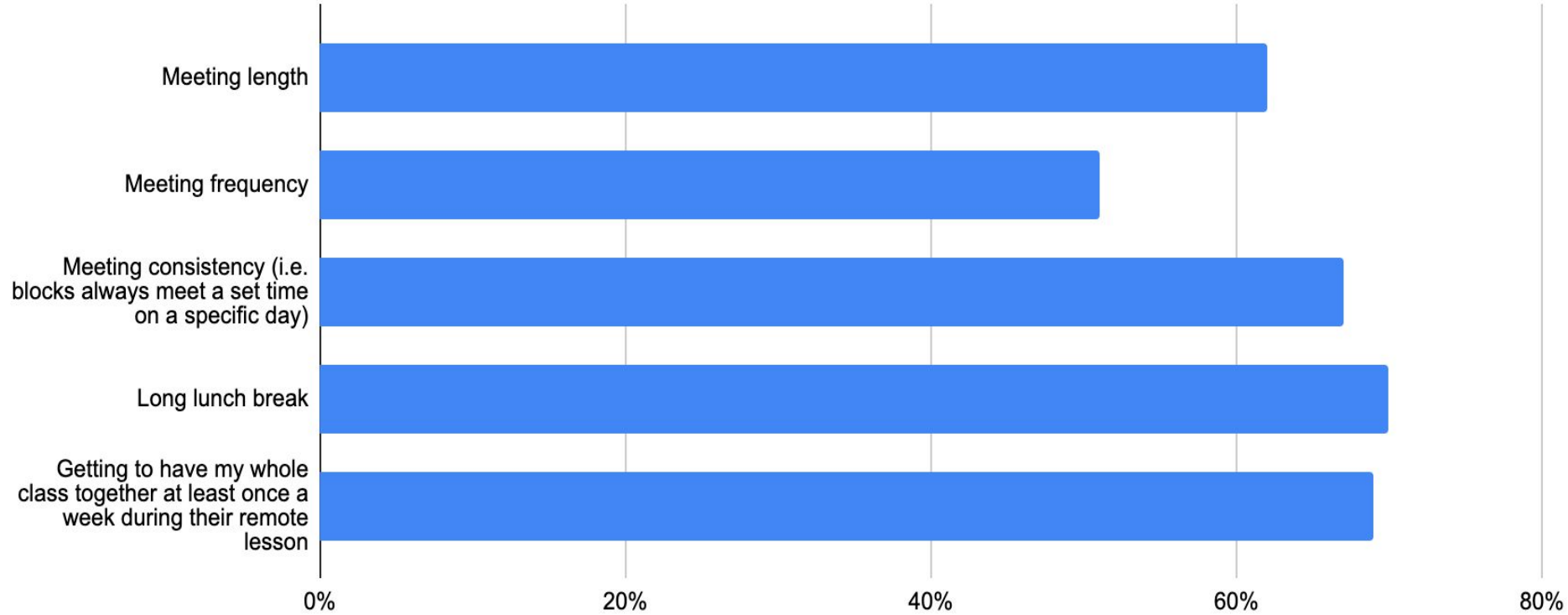

1 = Not Great

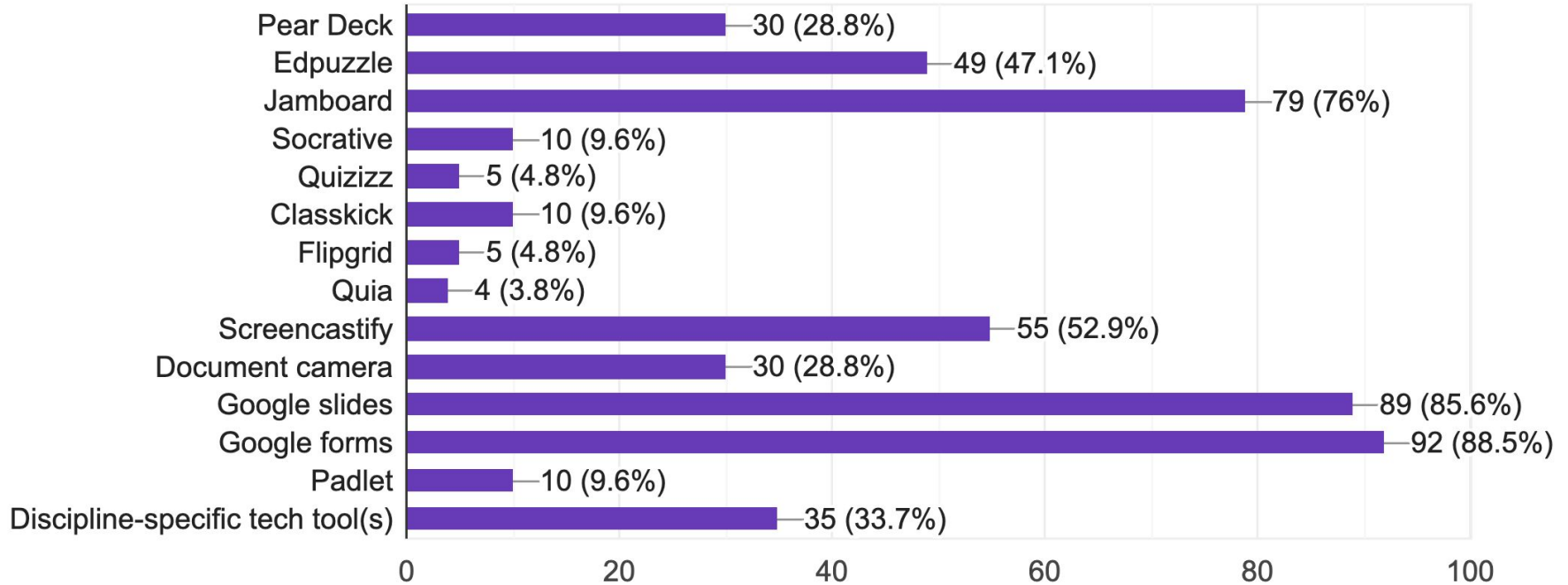
5 = Really well

Staff survey: Questions about students who are not in-person

The most frequent method, among respondents was live streaming to/with students at home

- AND -

There were other methods

- Separate activities during class time
 - And accessible at any time
- Meeting with cohort R students separately
- Asynchronous screencasts

Soliciting student feedback about specific classes

- Majority of teachers did collect feedback from their students first semester
 - Surveys & conversations
 - Both teachers and students who reported that classes that were “going really well” incorporated lots of student feedback
 - Student feedback provided positive energy for students and teachers
- DCs and administrators will encourage even more frequency this coming semester
 - Across respondents frequency of soliciting this feedback varied
 - We had not discussed or determined a recommended number of these “check-ins” first semester

Staff Survey - takeaways

- This challenge created opportunities for staff to learn and grow
 - New technology and new ways of using existing technology
- Bringing students together is critical work
 - Whole class
 - Small group
- Feedback from teachers, and to teachers, is critical to student learning
