

Clean Up Your Habitat Directions:

1. Research or brainstorm a list of native plants, insects or other organisms in your area.
2. Walk around in your own yard, at a local park (observing Social Distancing), or at a State Park or Wildlife Management Area. Take notes on any problems you see such as litter/pollution, habitat loss or misuse of natural resources. Additionally, note any instances of native plants or animals.
3. Determine a feasible solution for restoring the habitat around your area. Examples of ideas may be a method of reducing litter, developing a way to reduce water usage or even a plan to reintroduce native plants to the grounds. Your ideas should be creative and specific to your area.
